What's in your Basket

All items are grown on Lattin Farms, a certified organic farm, except for the produce marked with an asterisk (*).

- Carrots
- Turnips
- Beets
- Mizuna
- Asparagus
- Kale
- Zucchini
- Garlic Chives* (Medwaldt Organics)
- French Taragon* (Coblentz Gardens)
- Cabbage* (Pioneer Farms)
- Radishes* (Pioneer or Riverbend Farms)
- Broccoli* (Snyder Family Farms)

Please refrigerate all produce as soon as possible.
