All items are grown on Lattin Farms, a certified organic farm, except for the produce marked with an asterisk (*).

- Sarah Choice Cantaloupe
- Seedless Watermelon
- Summer Squash
- Cherry Tomatoes
- Early Girl Tomatoes
- Rosemary
- Anaheim and Bell Peppers
- Garlic Bulbs
- Purple Green Beans
- Cucumbers (pickling, slicing, Armenian, and lemon)
- Yellow Onions (Pioneer Farm)
- Sweet Corn (Snyder Farms) **The corn in your basket was grown using organic principles meaning the corn may still contain worms.**

Please refrigerate all produce as soon as possible.
