Down on the Farm Notes

I love this time of the year when summer begins to turn into autumn. The mornings are getting chillier, the days a little cooler, and our winter squash is starting to show up. So much happens in fall for the farm. We have our Cantaloupe Festival, Goat Days, and Fall Festival.

During **Labor Day Weekend**, if you are looking for something fun to do, come down for our **Fallon Cantaloupe Festival and Country Fair**. We will be there selling our great produce, including our many varieties of cantaloupe. Not only

do you get to experience our cantaloupes, there will be cantaloupe breads, jams, drinks and many other things make this festival different and fun. It begins on **Friday, September 4th and goes through Monday, September 7th**.

A few weeks after on **Saturday, September 26th**, we will have **Goat Days**. There are goat contests, taste testing, and lots of goats. It is a fun way to spend the day. In addition to Goat Days, it will be the first day that we open the **Family Fun Corn Maze**. It will be the first of our two Moonlight mazes, where the moon shines brightly to help light your path.

The next weekend starts our Fall Festival. Each Friday night and Saturday, our farm will be filled with corn maze, pumpkin patches, and crafters market to name a few things. We have a **Pumpkin Tower** that contains over 200 jack o lanterns which is **lit at dusk on Saturday, October 17th**. In addition, we will be open from 10-8 on **Nevada Day, Friday, October 30th**.

Also, we will have a **Scarecrow Factory on Saturdays, October 10th, 17th, and 24th**. It is run by different fundraising organizations and all proceeds benefit the youth of Fallon. They run out of material pretty quickly, so it is better to show up earlier than later in the day.

I know that sometimes schedules may prevent a visit on a Friday or Saturday, but don't fear. If you visit us Monday-Thursday, we can usually accommodate your needs.
